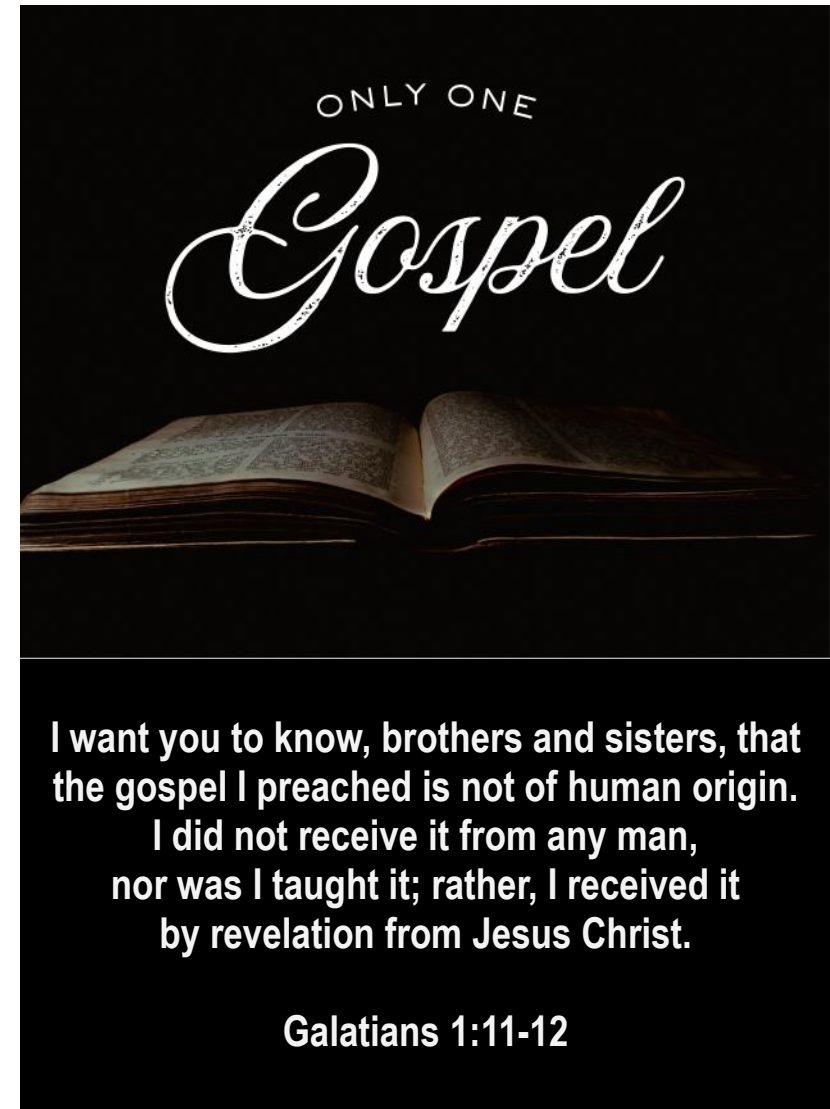

*We are seeing something happening on WCC's podcast to thank God for! Last year, our podcast ministry grew 39%, with a total of 6,836 downloads. In the last 90 days 3,222 podcasts were downloaded, 2,633 in the last 30 days, and 951 in just the last 7 days. This growth continues to show new locations where our podcast listeners are tuning in for the first time.
