Nursery
Provided for children during the worship service for ages birth to three. The nursery is located in the mezzanine upstairs on the right.

As a pattern, children in the nursery and children's church will only be released to an adult parent or guardian after the worship service is completed. Our volunteers will wait for you to come pick them up.
